Sonic roots deeply connected to the sacred heart of Southern Italy's folk music meet the sounds of modernity through loop station, guitars, and electronics. Ra di Spina does not perform tradition: they stretch it, open it, push it until it becomes alive. There is something profoundly physical in their proposal, almost visceral, a movement that shifts from the fragile to the untamed, from intimate invocation to collective celebration.

Led by Laura Cuomo on vocals and electronics, alongside guitarist Ernesto Nobili, vocalist Alexandra Ida Mauro, and percussionist Francesco Paolo Manna, the group restructures and intertwines stories of love, ritual chants, invocations, and memories, reimagining traditional repertoires with a contemporary sensibility.
